

Pipe Jetting & Flushing Services

Pipe Jetting/Flushing: effectively removes various types of debris and build up from pipelines and sewer systems using water jetters and vacuum trucks.

Services:

- **Pipe jetting / flushing:** Utilizes a Sewer Vacuum Truck with an industrial-grade water Jetter hose and nozzle to pressure wash pipelines. Essential for removing debris and maintaining clear flow in storm culverts, sewer lines, and landfill leachate systems, Facility Production Piping Service, Sanitary Sewers.
- **Vacuum Cleaning (Wet/Dry):** Powerful vacuum systems remove grit, debris, sand debris, mud debris and liquids, including scale buildup from catch basins and chemical sewers to prevent blockages.
- **CCTV Pipeline Inspection With Report:** CCTV Pipeline Inspection: Uses cameras to visually inspect pipe interiors for damage, leaks, or obstructions. Provides detailed reports on the condition of pipes, catch basins, culverts, drain lines, and leachate lines.
- **Storm Drain Catch Basin Clean-Outs and Jetting of Lines Between Basins:** High-powered vacuum/jetter trucks clean the sides and bottoms of catch basins, removing debris like leaves, trash, and sediment. Jetting clears clogs in connecting lines to restore normal water flow. This service prevents backups, flooding, and pavement degradation.

Complementing Services:

- **Vacuum or Hydro Excavation:** Uses high-pressure water to safely expose underground utilities without damaging them. This service is useful for precise digging and locating utilities before any major excavation work.
- **Manhole Inspection:** Involves detailed inspection of manholes to assess their condition and identify any necessary repairs. This is crucial for maintaining the integrity of sewer systems and preventing potential collapses or blockages.

What do we remove:

Grease and Fat: Accumulations from kitchens and food processing facilities.

Sludge and Grime: General buildup from wastewater and industrial processes.

Sand and Silt: Deposits from stormwater and erosion.

Scale and Mineral Deposits: Hard water buildup inside pipes.

Tree Roots: Intrusions that can block or damage sewer lines.

Debris and Trash: General waste that can clog pipes.

Chemical Residues: Leftover materials from industrial processes.

Oil and Grease Plugs: Common in automotive and manufacturing facilities.
